Nursery Developments

We have made good progress with the school building development project.

We have plans to demolish the huts and extend the car park so that we can relieve congestion around the school, improving parking conditions for local residents and staff. The removal of the first hut is due to start on Saturday.

The nursery hut will be removed and this area will be turned into a play area for the younger children. We will be placing the plans on the notice board in the next few weeks. Our aim is for building work to commence at the end of July.
